Reconciliation	DEFINITION: Hospital discharge medications reconciled with the member's current medication list.					
Enhanced Payment	 Enhanced Payment for Medication Reconciliation Visit referred by a SCHA Care Coordinator In order for a Public Health or Home Health Care agencies to receive the Enhanced Payment, the following must occur: The Medication Reconciliation was referred by a SCHA Care Coordinator The entity providing the Medication Reconciliation Visit completes the SCHA Medication Reconciliation form and sends a copy to the referring Care Coordinator The CPT-II: 1111F code is billed to SCHA on a separate line item connected to one of the four following HCPC codes: T1015, S9123, T1030, or G0154

	 Eligible providers: Public Health Nurses Licensed Registered Nurses, supervised by PHN, practicing in a PHNC Covered Services under the Public Health Nursing Clinic: Medication Management: Review of current medications and adherence to the prescribed medication regime. Education on proper medication use and contact with the prescribing physician when necessary. 					
	** Medication Management does NOT include a medication set-up in pill trays, medication machines, etc A medication set-up is considered a skilled nursing task and is not permitted under this covered service. Billing for PHNC: Must use both the HCPC and CPT-II code when billing

	S9123	Nursing care, in the home or place of residence, by PHN or registered nurse	1 encounter	Although, S9123 is a perhour service, SCHA allows 1 unit per date of service regardless of the actual time spent providing the service.		

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Medicare-certified Agency: Per DHS, if a county Public Health Nurse is providing a Public Health Nursing Clinic visit, the county agency would bill utilizing the S9123 code. The activity determines the billing code, not that it's a public health nurse that works for a county agency that is also Medicare-certified.

CPT-II codes are billed in the procedure code field with a \$125.00 billable charge amount.

Billing for SNV: Must use both the HCPC and CPT-II code when billing

Medication reconciliation is a component of a skilled nurse visit when a member is discharged from the hospital. In order to capture that the task was completed and enhanced payment can be paid, the CPT-II code needs to be billed.
